



**Stephen H. Sumida**

Stephen H. Sumida is a Fulbright Professor (2007-2008) teaching topics in American Studies at Tsuda College and Tokyo Institute of Technology, Japan, and is a Professor of American Ethnic Studies and an Adjunct Professor of English at the University of Washington in Seattle. His research and publications include work in Asian/Pacific American Literature, interdisciplinary American Studies, and comparative American ethnic literature. Among his books are *And the View from the Shore: Literary Traditions of Hawai'i* (1991) and, co-edited with Sau-ling Cynthia Wong, *A Resource Guide to Asian American Literature* (2001). Professor Sumida has served as the President of the American Studies Association (ASA, 2002-2003) and the Association for Asian American Studies (1999-2000), which presented him with its first Book Award in Cultural Studies for his *And the View from the Shore*. Outside the United States, he has lectured on American Studies in India, Singapore, Japan, South Korea, and Syria.
