Dr. Robert Sutter specialized in Asian and Pacific Affairs and US foreign policy in a US government career of 33 years involving the Congressional Research Service of the Library of Congress, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Department of State, and the Senate Foreign Relations Committee. He was for many years the Senior Specialist and Director of the Foreign Affairs and National Defense Division of the Congressional Research Service. He also was the National Intelligence Officer for East Asia and the Pacific at the US Government's National Intelligence Council, and the China Division Director at the Department of State's Bureau of Intelligence and Research.

A Ph.D. graduate in History and East Asian Languages from Harvard University, Robert Sutter taught part-time for over thirty years at Georgetown, George Washington, Johns Hopkins Universities, or the University of Virginia. His current full-time position is Visiting Professor of Asian Studies at the School of Foreign Service, Georgetown University. He has published 16 books, numerous articles and several hundred government reports dealing with contemporary East Asian and Pacific countries and their relations with the United States. His most recent book is *Chinese Foreign Relations: Power and Policy since the Cold War* (Rowman and Littlefield 2007).

羅伯·沙特博士擔任美國政府公職長達 33 年，專長於亞太事務及美國外交政策，服務過的機關包括國會圖書館研究處、中央情報局、國務院、及參議院外交關係委員會。他曾任國會研究處資深專員及外交國防組組長多年；也是美國政府國家情報委員會前東亞暨太平洋情報官，及國務院情報暨研究局中國組組長。

沙特是哈佛大學歷史及東亞語文博士，在喬治城大學、喬治華盛頓大學、約翰霍普金斯大學、及維吉尼亞大學兼任教職逾卅年，他目前是喬治城大學外交學院的亞洲研究專任客座教授。沙特出版過 16 本專書，發表過無數論文及數百項政府報告，主題均是現代東亞及太平洋國家及它們與美國的關係。他最新出版的著作是《Chinese Foreign

Relations: Power and Policy since the Cold War》 (Rowman and Littlefield 2007) ◦
