Kerry Dumbaugh since 1985 has been a specialist in Asian Affairs at the Foreign Affairs, Defense, and Trade Division of the Congressional Research Service, a research arm of the U.S. Congress. Her research has focused on China, Taiwan, and Hong Kong, primarily on U.S. relations with these governments. She has been working in Washington D.C. in various policy capacities since 1977. She spent eight years working as a Legislative Assistant for Members of Congress, including Senator H. John Heinz, Congressman Joseph Fisher, and as Legislative Director for Congressman Jack Hightower.

In 1984-85, she served as Executive Assistant and Research Fellow at the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) in Washington DC. Ms. Dumbaugh specializes in analyzing political, security, and human rights developments in China, Hong Kong, and Taiwan, and has written extensively on U.S. policy in Asia. She also is the moderator for a public TV program in the Washington area, "The China Forum." Ms. Dumbaugh holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Wittenberg University; a Master of Arts degree in East Asian Studies from the University of Pennsylvania; and a Master of Science degree in National Security Studies from the U.S. National War College in Washington D.C.

鄧凱麗自 1985 年起即是美國國會研究處外交、國防暨貿易組的亞洲事務專家。她的研究著重於中國、台灣和香港，主要是美國與這三地政府的關係。自 1977 年起她便在華府工作，擔任不同的政策職位。她歷任參議員約翰·海茲（H. John Heinz）、眾議員約瑟夫·費雪（Joseph Fisher）等國會議員的立法助理，及眾議員傑克·海陶爾（Jack Hightower）的立法主任，共計長達八年時間。1984-85 年她擔任華府戰略與國際研究中心（CSIS）執行助理和研究員。鄧女士專長於分析中國、香港和台灣的政治、安全和人權發展，並撰寫過許多關於美國亞洲政策的著作。她也是華府地區公共電視節目「中國論壇」（The China Forum）的主持人。鄧凱麗獲有威騰堡大學學士、賓州大學亞洲研究碩士、及美國國家戰爭學院的國家安全研究碩士等學位。
